



POLICY FOR PROTECTING CHILDREN'S RIGHTS AND PREVENTING ABUSE

Children's rights are universal concepts used to define all of the rights that all children in the world have by birth, legally or morally; such as education, health, life, shelter, protection against physical, psychological or sexual exploitation.

Child abuse is the physical or psychological mistreatment of a child by an adult.

In addition, child maltreatment is often synonymous with child abuse.

The World Health Organization defines child abuse as follows: "All behaviors that adversely affect the health, physical and psychosocial development of a child, applied knowingly or unknowingly by an adult, society or the state, are child maltreatment."

According to our policy;

- Do not leave your children under the age of 0-12 alone in your room,
- Do not allow your children under the age of 0-12 to ride the elevators alone,
- Do not leave your children with strangers in the hotel and do not leave the hotel,
- Do not allow your children under the age of 18 to consume alcohol,
- Respect children's rights,
- Do not engage in behaviors that are aimed at child neglect and abuse,
- Report people who act against children's rights and abuse to the management,
- We kindly request you, our valued guests and employees.
- In line with the complaints reported; the security forces will be informed by the management and the necessary legal procedures will be implemented.

According to national and international laws regarding the protection of children's rights, child abuse has penal sanctions and imprisonment.
